LIMITED SPACE – Auditioned program

As we are extremely limited to only 40 students, and the age we are accepting is 9 and above, we will only be accepting registrants by audition only. Please send your child singing their favourite Disney song (no pop music please) to youthtroupe@bramptonmusictheatre.com. Please feel free to perform as much as you like during the video.

Session hours – Classes are now 40 minutes

Please note your child will receive 1 class of music, drama and dance in the 2 hours of the program. There will be no break or snack at this time, please only send water with your child.

Participation is \$150 (and a production fee of \$50 to cover the cost of the script and membership) and rehearsal are Sunday evenings 4:30-8 pm, February 20th and go until show April 28th-30th. Absenteeism

Sign in/ Pick up

At Brampton Music Theatre we care about your child's safety. It is our policy that all children must be signed into class by an adult every week and that a parent must come into the building to pick up their child. Do not wait in the parking lot or drop off your child at the door. We want to see your lovely faces and get to know you. Also do park your car outside along Nelson. Park in the lot behind the studio and come in. Children over the age of 16 can sign in and leave unattended.

Proper Footwear

Your children must wear proper footwear for dance class or alternatively go barefeet. This can be either a jazz shoe from 2leftfeet or ballet slippers.

Electronics

Do not send your child to classes with electronics – they are not permitted in the classroom. Phones are only permitted to contact parents for pick up and are not required during the day.

Showcase

The children will be studying a musical and a song from a musical. They will be rehearsing this for the 10 weeks of class and will perform this on the last day of classes on April 22nd. 2022

Class cancellations due to weather or school permit closures

If the weather is bad, we may cancel the program. You will be EMAILED. Please be sure we have your correct email address when registering.

COVID 19, PLEASE READ.

Brampton Music Theatre does **not require vaccination** status be revealed to participate in this production. BMT wants to remain an inclusive organization for all. As such, this will not be a requirement. If you do not want your child around others whose status is unknown, **please do not register for the program. We ask that children not disclose/request this information of others.**

The city of Brampton permits the removal of masks for the purposes of **actively rehearsing**. As this will be **MOST OF THE TIME**, your child will be working without a mask during the program. If you are not prepared to participate in an activity where this is the case, **please do not register.**

Lastly all 5 of the 5 members of the teaching team have had Covid and recovered. They will also be removing their masks to rehearse. If you are not comfortable sending your child to this production under these circumstances, **please do not register.**

BMT leave the decisions of the well-being of their child in the hands of their parent.
